What is XANGO Reserva?

XANGO Reserva offers a truly uncommon experience as the premium XANGO beverage. Incorporating a refined and complex flavor XANGO Reserva is sure to impress even the most sophisticated of palates. And with an enhanced formula delivering 20% more mangosteen goodness, every glass enjoyed—along with its greater phytonutrient content—is sure to be highly esteemed. Think of Reserva as greatness refined.

Why is XANGO introducing XANGO Reserva now?

As XANGO's premium edition mangosteen beverage, the Reserva formula represents years of reinventing and refinement of our already highly-polished flavor system to deliver the most exquisite mangosteen experience imaginable.

How does XANGO Reserva differ from the original XANGO Juice (and how is it similar)?

XANGO Reserva is certainly more similar to XANGO Juice than different. The primary ingredient in both formulas is mangosteen, the same science validates both products and the same manufacturing facilities with high quality standards produce both formulas.

Reserva differs in its flavor offering a complex and sophisticated aroma. Also, an exclusive manufacturing process enables higher mangosteen content while other fruit juices are used to rebalance the flavor into a bright but not too sweet flavor that even the most sophisticated palates will appreciate.

What is the recommended serving size of XANGO Reserva?

As a mixture of natural fruit juices and purees, it is safe to drink as much or as little as you like. We recommend that you tailor your consumption to fit your personal preferences.

What science exists on XANGO Reserva?

XANGO Reserva is supported by the same science and research as our original XANGO Juice, yet Reserva's higher mangosteen concentration naturally offers a greater amount of phytonutrients.

What is the shelf life of XANGO Reserva?

While XANGO Reserva boasts a shelf life of two years in an unopened bottle, it is always preferable to check the "Best by" date on the bottom of each bottle. Once opened, the bottle should be refrigerated and consumed within 30 days.



What are xanthones?

Xanthones are powerful phytonutrients—naturally occurring in plants—that have won high praise from numerous scientists and researchers. Major scientific institutions around the world continue to study xanthones and their benefits.

Where does the mangosteen fruit come from?

Native to Southeast Asia and the national fruit of Thailand, the mangosteen is a delicate fruit that only grows under perfect conditions. Enthusiasts of the mangosteen have attempted to grow it elsewhere, but have experienced limited success in Australia and small pockets of South America and the Caribbean.

Is the harvesting of the mangosteen fruit environmentally friendly?

Fortunately, the mangosteen has its own natural defense against pests that includes yellow latex that it excretes to smother any predators. Because of this, no pesticides are used on the crop that XANGO cultivates for its products. Likewise, XANGO chooses not to use other chemical treatments during the harvest.

What are the ingredients in XANGO Reserva?

Rich in xanthones, the mangosteen helps to provide the benefits of XANGO Reserva. XANGO Reserva is made from a puree of the mangosteen fruit. A few additional natural fruit juices are blended, according to a proprietary formula, to round off the flavor and create XANGO Reserva's unique taste.

Is the amount of xanthones per bottle standardized?

XANGO Reserva is a natural blend of the mangosteen fruit with no extracts. There are some slight variations from batch to batch due to the natural variations in the mangosteen fruit.

How much mangosteen is in XANGO Reserva?

The amount of mangosteen in XANGO Reserva is part of our proprietary formula and therefore we don't disclose it. However, XANGO Reserva boasts 20% more mangosteen content when compared to our original formula.

Is it safe to take XANGO Reserva with medications?

There are no known contraindications with XANGO Reserva and medications. However, if you are consuming any medications or have a known medical condition it is best to consult with your health care provider or pharmacist before consuming XANGO Reserva.

Is XANGO Reserva safe for everyone?

Yes. XANGO Reserva is made from the mangosteen fruit (*Garcinia mangostana*) and various other fruit juices. It is safe to consume as much or as little as you like. XANGO Reserva meets the highest safety and manufacturing standards and has been tested to be safe for anyone ages 2 to 90 years old.



How safe is the production of XANGO Reserva?

We have a strategic production partnership with an ISO 9001-certified food-and-beverage-industry giant. Before you consume XANGO Reserva it goes through more than 220 quality tests to ensure it meets the highest standards of cleanliness and quality in the world.

Is XANGO Reserva pasteurized or heat processed?

Yes. Government regulations require either pasteurization for the safety of consumers or a warning label of possible microbial contamination in products that are not pasteurized. Extensive research reveals that these processes do not affect the xanthone content or efficacy in XANGO Reserva, largely because the mangosteen is one of a select number of fruits that retains its nutritional value under heat.

Are there any preservatives in XANGO Reserva?

Potassium sorbate and sodium benzoate are added to ensure the safety of XANGO Reserva and are included at levels allowed and deemed safe under EU food regulations. . They are used as antimicrobial agents in very small amounts, and added as part of the world-recognized Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP) in food and beverage processing.

Is XANGO Reserva organic?

XANGO Reserva is not certified organic; however, the mangosteen used in XANGO Reserva is pesticide-free. Also, XANGO Reserva is unique as it uses the fresh mangosteen fruit rather than a concentrate of the “queen of fruits.”

What kinds of sugars are used in XANGO Reserva?

There are no added sugars in XANGO Reserva, only naturally occurring fructose.

Does XANGO Reserva contain potassium?

The fruits used in formulating XANGO Reserva contain potassium as a natural component. Our analysis shows potassium levels at 210mg/100g.

Does XANGO Reserva contain MSG?

No. XANGO Reserva is free of MSG.

Does XANGO Reserva contain gluten?

No. XANGO Reserva is naturally gluten free.

Does XANGO Reserva contain vitamin K?

No. XANGO Reserva does not contain vitamin K.



Does XANGO Reserva contain any sulfur?

No. XANGO Reserva does not contain any sulfur.

Does XANGO Reserva contain any silicates?

No. XANGO Reserva does not contain any silicates.

Is XANGO Reserva Kosher?

Information about Bioflavonoids in XANGO Reserva.

What are Bioflavonoids?

Bioflavonoids, also known simply as flavonoids, are found throughout the mangosteen. Flavonoids are compounds responsible for the coloring in fruits, vegetables and herbs. Catechins and Proanthocyanidins are two exciting bioflavonoids and happen to be found in significant amounts in the mangosteen fruit.

What are Catechins?

Catechins are flavonoid phytochemical compounds—often referred to as “tea flavonoids”—that are being studied by scientists worldwide. In experimental models, catechins show a wide range of beneficial effects.

What are Proanthocyanidins?

Proanthocyanidins are flavonoids that help in the stabilization of two critical proteins in the body.
